

Components of Movement & The Principles of Neurodevelopmental Treatment (NDT)

This one-week workshop is open to registered physical, occupational, and speech therapists working primarily with children who have developmental disorders. NDT certification is not required.

OBJECTIVES

The participants shall:

1. Gain an understanding of the intricate, subtle components of normal and abnormal motor development and their interplay.
2. Learn to recognize compensations and deviations from normal development.
3. Practice methods of facilitating desired movement while inhibiting undesired motor activity.
